

## MINUTES OF WORKSHOP: JULY 13, 2021

Mayor Muska called the workshop to order at 5:33 pm. Tommy Muska, Natalie Kelinske, David Pratka, Joe Pustejovsky, and Jimmy Doherty were present. Steve Vanek was absent.

Fire Marshal Harold Pfeiderer was present and went over the fire department needs. He entertained the idea of a new ladder truck and possibly refurbishing one of the "twin" trucks. He also presented figures if we decide to buy new verses used and presented financing options.

Shelly Nors and Mayor Muska went over the estimated cash on hand balance for the fiscal year 2021-2022.

Mayor Muska stated that CJ Gillaspie would like to add a lawnmower to his General Fund capital outlay budget of \$10,000. Shelly Nors will add it into the figures for next Thursday's meeting.

Jimmy Doherty said that the library received a quote from H&R Carpet to replace the flooring that was damaged during the heavy rains we received this year. The quote came in at \$8,000. H&R Carpet suggested to go ahead and order the flooring now since the prices seem to keep rising and the library could pay ½ now and the rest for next years budget. Mayor Muska put in extra money in general fund building repair and maintenance which should cover their request.

No other changes or additions to the proposed budget were requested at this time.


Natalie Kelinske would like to go over developer incentives at the next meeting. She would like some sort of process in place for when developers ask for assistance from the council.
