- 1. Call to order: Mayor Muska called the meeting to order at 5:35 PM.
- 2. Roll Call: present council members Mayor Tommy Muska, Cody Harris, Natalie Kelinske, David Pratka, Joe Pustejovsky, and Steve Vanek were present. Fire Marshal, Harold Pfleiderer and Interim Police Chief, Ashley Boyd were also in attendance.
- 3. Council reviewed the revised budget packet. Harold Pfleiderer went over the EMS budget requests in detail. He and his committee have been meeting with the West EMS regarding the management and financial issues of the EMS and are trying to come up with solutions to help remedy their problems.
